




2025 BRIGHT SMILES CHARITY RIDE

Thursday 1st May to Monday 5th May

2025 will see the Bright Smiles Charity Ride (BSCR) celebrate its tenth year raising funds for the Royal Flying Doctor Service South-Eastern Section Dental Program and nearly \$ 500,000 has been raised by the event to date.

The BSCR will start with drinks & dinner at Batemans Bay on Thursday evening 1st May 2025, then we will spend the Friday & Saturday nights in the High-Country Capital of Corryong, and the Sunday night in Cowra. We will finish at lunchtime on Monday 5th May in Kurrajong Heights, in the sunny Blue Mountains.







Each day of the BSCR is designed to be ridden in 2 or 3 (or more) sections and is designed to fit in more with the mixed riding skills of our group. This enables the day to flow a little easier for the early birds, or those who decide to take a side trip and ride a few extra kms.

You will make your own arrangements each day for breakfast & lunch, which means we won't all need to leave town at the same time. If you want to get up and get going early after just a cup of coffee, you won't have to hang back at the lunch stop for those who decided to enjoy a more leisurely start to the day with a sleep in and a 3-course breakfast. The same goes for lunch - if you decide you want to just grab a quick snack, do just that and we will catch up and compare notes at the **HAPPY HOUR**.

Every afternoon we will continue to host the hugely popular **HAPPY HOUR**, and we will have our group dinner at a nice restaurant or pub every night. The dinner and happy hour are included in the disbursements fee, and you pay for breakfast and lunch, and drinks with your meals, yourself.

To make things a little more comfortable for riders (and to enable you to frock up for dinner each evening if you wish), a luggage car is provided (soft bags only please) so you don't have to load up your bike too much. The luggage car will also tow a breakdown trailer, just in case.

N.B. The main use of the trailer in recent years has been due to tyre troubles and running out of fuel. As it is hard to get motorcycle tyres in the majority of country towns, please make sure <u>in advance of the event</u> that your tyres are able to last the distance without needing to be replaced part way around the route (or perhaps bring a spare tyre in the luggage car).

AND check your fuel distances each day, an emergency fuel refill on the side of the road will cost you a \$50 donation to the RFDS.

Thursday 1st May 2025

Welcome drinks and dinner in Batemans Bay. We are booked into the Zorba Waterfront Motel in Batemans Bay.

Welcome to the tenth Bright Smiles Charity Ride. Riders & volunteers will gather at the Zorba Waterfront Motel, and we will walk to our pre-dinner drinks and briefing location at 5:00 pm, and then onto our dinner at 6:30 pm.

Day 1, Friday 2nd May 2025.

Batemans Bay to Corryong

Tonight we are at the Corryong Hotel/Motel (we stay at Corryong 2 nights)

Approximately 442 km, 5:45 hours riding time

Today is a longer day than normal, but the hero of today's ride - the section between Jindabyne & Khancoban - makes it all worthwhile.

We start the day with a ride on the back roads along the coastline via Malua Bay, then join the Pacific Highway at Moruya and turn south. There are lots of places to pull up for coffee and to stretch your legs (and don't forget fuel - maybe at Nimmitabel - as Jindabyne is 300 km from Batemans Bay). You turn right off the Pacific Highway about 10 km north of Bega and from here ride through Nimmitabel, Dalgety and Jindabyne.





Then we ride up and over the top of the alps at Thredbo, then down the other side through Khancoban and along the Thowlga Valley into Corryong.

HAPPY HOUR will be at the Corryong Hotel from approx. 4:30 pm, and dinner tonight will be at the pub.

(Suggest everybody fuel tonight. The BP is 24x7.)

Day 2, Saturday 3rd May 2025 Corryong to Hume Weir, and return to Corryong Approximately 285 km, 3:25 hours riding time

Today is a more leisurely day, and the suggested route out of town follows the southern side of the Murray River through majestic valleys full of postcard like vistas. There is fuel is at Walwa and if you are coming back this way I suggest, if you can't make the 300 km return trip, you fill at Walwa on your way to the Hume Weir. They only have small tanks; don't run the risk of them running out on a Saturday afternoon.





After Jinjellic the Murray River widens at Thologolong, and we ride along the twisting and winding banks of the north arm of Lake Hume for 60 km to the Bethanga Bridge. This road is custom built for motor cyclists and the views are spectacular all the way into Hume Village.

Once we cross over the Murray River back into NSW you have a decision to make. Do you head back to Corryong along the Murray River the way you came, or do you head south-east, and travel back on the main roads, along the equally picturesque southern arm of Lake Hume, past Tallangatta? This trip past Tallangatta and through Koetong is slightly shorter, however there is no fuel on this leg.

HAPPY HOUR will be in the Corryong Hotel from approx. 4:30 pm, and dinner tonight will be at a location TBA.

Day 3 Sunday 4th May 2025 Corryong to Cowra

Tonight we are staying at the Club Cowra Motel

Approximately 336 km, 3:45 hours riding time


Today we head north, riding along the top of the western ridge of the incredibly beautiful Jagungal Wilderness Area. After about 30 minutes we pass the Southern Cloud Crash Memorial lookout and it is well worth a short break here to take in the views and grab a few happy snaps on your phone.

Our suggested route takes us through Tumut, reknowned as one of the best coffee culture towns in the Snowy Mountains, and then at Gundagai we join the M1 for a short while, before turning off at Coolac to ride via Wallendbeen, Wombat & Young to Cowra.

If you get into town in time, I strongly suggest a trip to the **Cowra Japanese Gardens**.

HAPPY HOUR will be in the car park of the motel from approx. 4:30 pm before we head off for a chinese feast at around 6:30.

OK - WHAT DOES IT COST?

The Entry Fee - \$200 per vehicle. Payable to the Royal Flying Doctor Service South-East Section.

Donations – participation in the Bright Smiles Charity Ride is a reward for raising \$1,250 (or more) for the Royal Flying Doctor Service S-E Section. All donations over \$2 are tax deductible.

Disbursements & Meal Money - \$400 per person is also payable to the Royal Flying Doctor Service. This fee covers your **HAPPY HOUR** drinks and your dinner each evening.

<u>Accommodation</u>: It is fair to say that accommodation is one of the more vexing issues of any trip like the BSCR. People might be on different budgets, different people like different styles of accommodation, some people might want to stay with friends or relatives, and so on. Often as the event approaches motel availability in the towns we visit starts to dry up, and a shortage of rooms has become especially common since COVID hit and more people started holidaying domestically.

As a precaution in each of our overnight towns I have pre-booked 15 "quite good" motel rooms for our group to use. If you want to take advantage of these rooms (at cost) book them through me via this Entry Form when you enter the event.

HOWEVER – you are under no requirement to use the rooms I have placed on hold – you may want to pitch a tent, or book your own room, or stay with a long-lost rich uncle, just let me know. The rooms I have reserved are on a first come basis and I will return any unused/unpaid for rooms 21 days prior to the event to the motel operator.

I acknowledge and agree as a condition of entry that neither the Bright Smiles Charity Ride, the Royal Flying Doctor Service nor the Promoters or the Sponsors' organisations, nor the land owners or lessees, nor the Organisers of the Event, or their respective servants, officials, representatives or agents ("the Organisers") shall be under any liability for my death or bodily injury, loss or damage which may be sustained or incurred by me, as a result of participation in or being present at the Event except where due skill and care has not been exercised.
